Program Overview

Canada's Outstanding Young Farmers Program recognizes young farmers who exemplify excellence in their profession. Nominees will prepare a presentation on their farming operation and will compete at a regional event in February. The 7 winners from Canada's regional events will then represent their respective region at the National Recognition Event the following winter.

Nominees are judged according to the following criteria:

- · Progress made in their agriculture career
- Environmental and safety practices
- Crop and livestock production history
- Financial and management practices
- Contributions to the well-being of their community, province and nation

Is Your Nominee Eligible?

Nominees may be an individual, couple or managing partner/shareholder of a farm group. Nominees may be two partners in a farming operation (i.e. siblings) who meet all the criteria requirements.

The nominee must:

- Be responsible for the majority of management decisions in operating the farm
- Derive a minimum of two-thirds of their gross revenue from agriculture
- Over 50% of the farm's income, averaged over the past 3 years, must be derived from the farm's primary production.
- Be aged 18 through 39; not becoming 40 prior to January 1 of the year of competition
